

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I. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

GSWA is looking to procure services for Household Hazardous Waste Transport and Disposal collected at the Household Hazardous Waste Facility. All operations performed shall comply with all applicable federal and local regulations.

COMPLY / NON-COMPLIANCE

Bidder shall provide all equipment necessary to sort, load, and transport hazardous waste from Household Hazardous Waste Facility in Harmon, Guam on an as needed basis to a permitted processing/disposal site.

Bidder shall collect the HHW within 48 hours of given notice. No pick up service will be required on weekends.

Bidder shall transport and dispose/recycle of properly collected HHW materials already packaged by GSWA, identifying GSWA as generator.

Bidder shall provide copies of completed manifest of HHW materials handled, disposal locations for materials collected; weight and volume of material diverted through recycling or reusing; other information regarding the transport and disposal of HHW as GSWA may reasonably require from time to time.

Bidder shall be liable for any general environmental pollution, not limited to sudden accidental discharge, bodily injury (including death), property damage, clean-up costs, and defense and settlement of all claims.

Bidder shall protect existing structures at the sites and repair any damage caused by its operation at no additional cost to the Government of Guam

Bidder shall ensure that all material delivered to permitted disposal sites is processed and/or managed in compliance with all Federal and local requirements.

Bidder must have approved permit(s) by GEPA.

If Bidder is unable to dispose of an item as a result of changes in restrictions by ocean carriers, Bidder must notify GSWA immediately so that material can be temporarily discontinued from collection at the HHW Facility. Bidder must also immediately inform GSWA when material can be accepted again.

II. CONTRACT TERM

The Contract Term shall be for two (2) years to commence on December 24, 2022 and shall continue until midnight of December 23, 2024. Renewal options will be one fiscal year at a time, not to exceed five (5) years and subject to availability of funds.
